

Call Today to Support SB 906 Prohibited Reptiles

Contact Senate Committee Members to support SB 906

Today at 4:30 pm the Senate Environment & Natural Resources Committee will meet to vote on SB 906 - Prohibited Reptiles.

Non native reptiles are a growing problem for many of Florida's native habitats including Sanibel and Captiva Islands. In fact, our own Geoff and Robbie Roepstorff have joined the fight to eradicate the Burmese Python in the Everglades!



SB 906 adds green iguanas and black and white tegus to the existing list of prohibited reptiles and strengthens existing provisions that prohibit the possession, importation, sale, trade and breeding of the Burmese or Indian python, the Northern African python, the Southern African python, the Amethystine or scrub python, the Green Anaconda and the Nile monitor. Since 2015, 4,915 green iguanas have been trapped and removed from Sanibel.
